IT Jobs

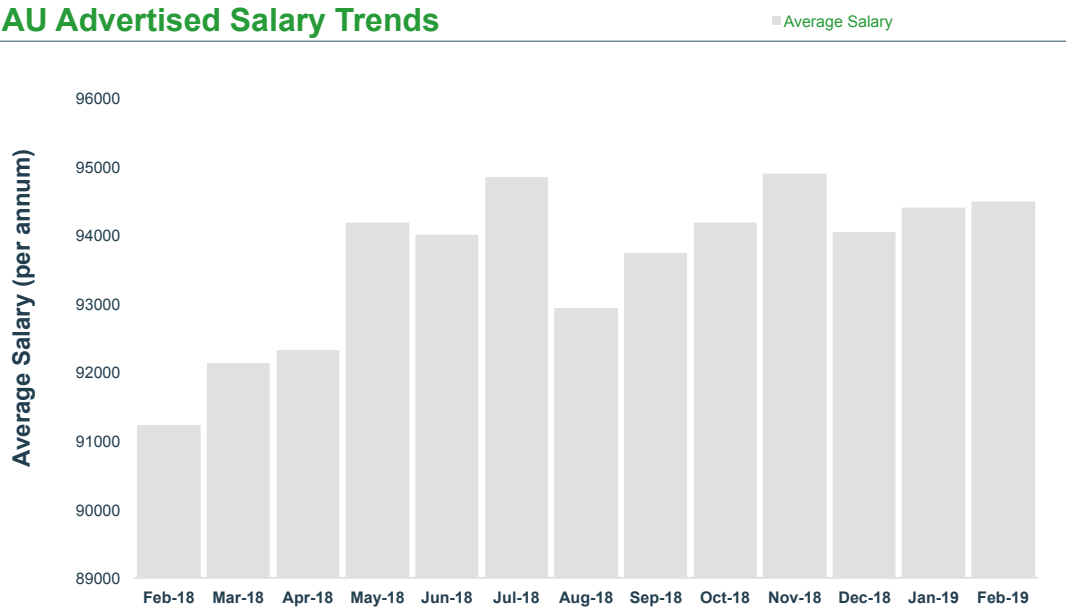
Job vacancies in the IT Industry increased 7% year-on-year.

Monthly change in advertised job vacancies

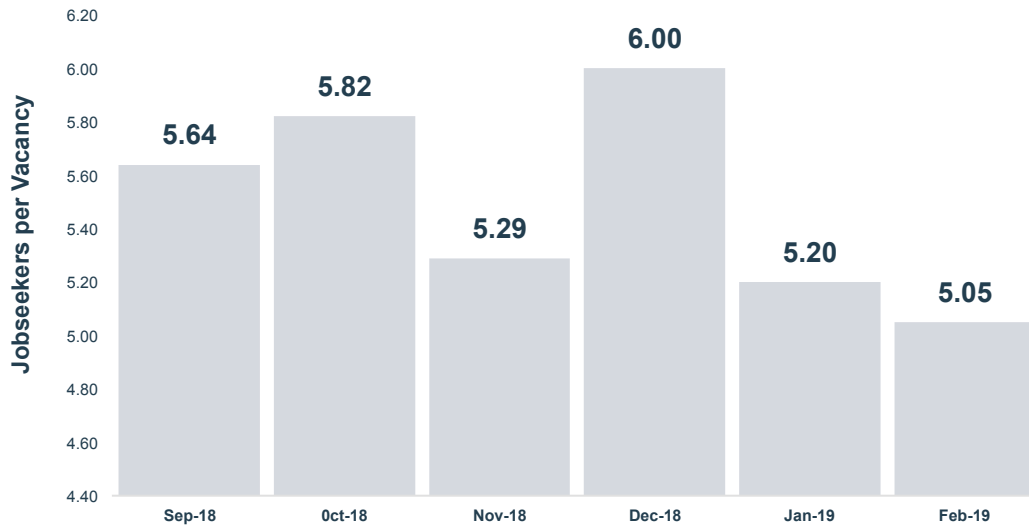


AU Advertised Salary Trends
